



# DEMYSTIFYING THE HYBRID

## IN ASSOCIATION WITH CRANE DENTAL LAB



### Program description

This lecture will present the history and current concepts for the Hybrid Denture (implant supported fixed denture). This treatment is a predictable treatment option for the edentulous patient. Dr. PI Branemark was the innovator of the original "hybrid" implant protocol that has been used successfully for over 40 years. Prosthetic rehabilitation of the edentulous patient with implant supported bridges has developed into a sound and viable treatment option. This approach appears intimidating to many restorative dentists and they may feel uncomfortable treatment planning these cases. This lecture will present numerous clinical cases to illustrate simple reproducible steps to seamlessly take you from the treatment planning process to the final restoration. Immediate placement-immediate loading of the hybrid versus the delayed approach of the restoration will also be discussed.
